Supplemental Rules and Regulations

Version C

Updated May 13, 2021

These Rules and Regulations were adopted by the Board of Directors to govern the operation of the pool during the summer of 2021. They supplement the general Rules and Regulations last updated by the board on March 1, 2018; where there is any conflict, these Rules take precedence.

These Rules are for the benefit and protection of all members and staff and must be adhered to. The Rules are subject to change by the Board of Directors without prior notice.

“Pool Manager” in these Rules means the Pool Manager or the person designated by the Pool Manager to be in charge of pool operations at any time. The Pool Manager may take action at any time, even contrary to these Rules, if he/she deems the action necessary for the safe operation of the pool.

Members are required to caution their children and their guests to observe all Rules and Regulations as well as the directions of the Pool Manager, lifeguards, and other supervisory employees of the Club. Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their children and guests at all times.

1. All individuals over the age of two (2) must wear masks on pool grounds unless they are swimming, showering, or sitting in their chairs.
2. Members are asked to observe social distance from others who are not part of their family, “pod”, or friend group.
3. The pool will have two lap lanes at all times, with a third lane to be added when main pool occupancy allows, at the sole discretion of the Pool Manager.
 - 3.1. For the two main lap lanes, we will have a reservation system that lets members reserve a lane in 15-minute increments, to a maximum of one hour. These lanes are open for unreserved use during unoccupied periods.
 - 3.2. When a third lap lane is available, that lane will be open for unreserved use.
4. Party reservations will not be allowed, and members will be limited to a maximum of 8 guests per visit.
5. In order to limit the number of people in the clubhouse, members will enter the grounds through the regular door and will exit through the gate by the baby pool.
 - 5.1. Food delivery people should be instructed to drop off in the parking lot. Members should be sure that they can be reached by phone when their food arrives.
6. Pool chairs will be set up by the staff at the start of each day in groups of 2 chairs, with space in between groups.
 - 6.1. Wipes will be available for members who wish to clean their chairs.

- 6.2. Members may move chairs in order to sit with other members if they so choose, but they are asked to return chairs to their original position when they leave.
- 6.3. The staff will periodically reset unoccupied chairs.
7. Although the clubhouse bathrooms will be open, the Club will also provide an outdoor shower for members who wish to use it.
8. Pool staff will all be vaccinated (except for any with religious or medical exemptions) and will wear masks when not on active guard duty.
