

Rules Concerning Payment of Annual Dues, 2025

The following Rules and Regulations concerning the payment of annual dues and continued membership in the Club have been established by the Board of Directors of the Mount Washington Swimming Club.

- As provided in the Club By-Laws, a member who resigns is entitled to a full refund of the member's subscription fee, without interest, only once a new member joins and pays a new subscription fee. Any outstanding dues, guest fees, or other charges will be deducted before any subscription fee is refunded.
- To avoid being charged annual dues in any year, a member must submit his/her resignation in writing no later than April 15 before the start of the pool season. If a resignation is submitted after April 15, a full refund of the subscription fee will be made only if a new member joins for that season and pays the full annual dues for that season.
- 3. Members unable to use the Club facilities for an entire season may submit a written request for a leave of absence **no later than April 15** before the start of the pool season. When economically feasible, a leave of absence will be granted for that season and the membership will be reserved for the following season. Any request for an additional leave of absence must be submitted for each season no later than April 15. If the request for a leave of absence is submitted after April 15, it will be granted only if the Club is able to obtain full annual dues from a new member for that season.
- 4. **Annual dues should be paid by April 15**. After this date, members will be assessed a late fee of \$25.
- 5. If payment of annual dues has not been received by April 15 (or 30 days after the annual dues invoice, if later), the Club reserves the right to suspend the member's privileges until payment in full of annual dues plus all applicable guest fees and late fees has been received.
- 6. If payment of annual dues has not been received by May 15, the Club reserves the right to terminate the membership and to invite a new member to join the Club. In that event, any amount of the annual dues of the terminated member that cannot be replaced from the new member will be deducted from the terminated member's subscription fee. Reinstatement of the terminated member after May 15 is at the discretion of the Board of Directors, and only upon full payment of all annual dues and other outstanding balance.
